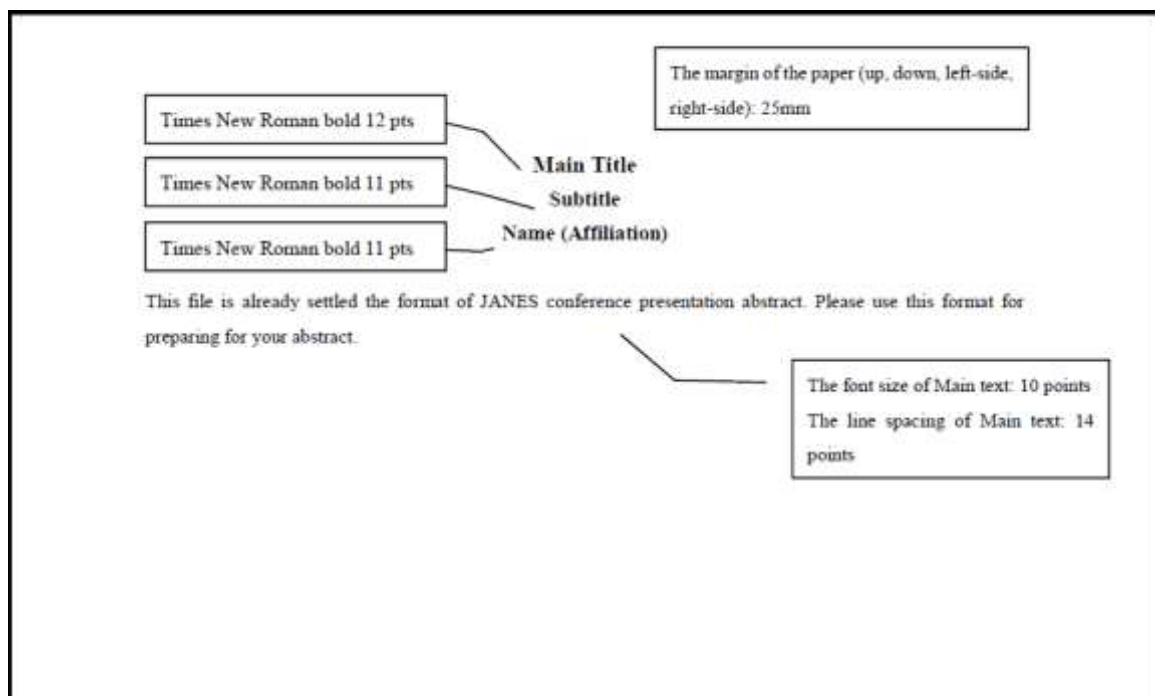
5. Procedure for preparing the abstract of the presentation

The main specifications are as follows. A template will be attached separately, so please use it for submission.

- The size of paper and the length of abstract: A4 paper, within 2 pages
- The margin of the paper (up, down, left-side, right-side): 25mm
- The font type: Times New Roman
- The font size of Main Title 12 points,
- The font size of Subtitle/Your name/Your affiliation: 11 points
- The font size of Main text: 10 points
- The line spacing of Main text: 14 points
- Main Title/Subtitle/Your name/your affiliation should center the page horizontally, please boldify Main Title/Subtitle/Your name/your affiliation

★ Make sure that it fits on one vertical sheet of A4 paper. The abstract should be within one page.

★ As a general rule, please send two files in a WORD file and a file converted to PDF.
